4-Way Win Raffle Official Rules

1. Eligibility

4-Way Win Raffle (the "Raffle") is open to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are at least eighteen (18) years old at the time of drawing. The Raffle is subject to federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

2. Sponsor

The Raffle is sponsored by The Greater West Chester Rotary Foundation, located at PO BOX 1176, West Chester, Pennsylvania 19341-0934.

3. Agreement to Official Rules

Participation in the Raffle constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and binding. Winning a prize is contingent upon being compliant with these Official Rules and fulfilling all other requirements set forth herein.

4. Raffle Period

The Raffle begins on November 21, 2024 at 1:00 pm and ends on April 04, 2025 at 8:00 pm or when all (3000) tickets are sold.

6. Prize Drawing & Notification

On April 04, 2025, the Sponsor will select winners in a random drawing from among all eligible Raffle tickets sold. The odds of being selected depend on the number of tickets sold (3000 ticket max). The Sponsor will attempt to notify the potential winner (s) via telephone on or about April 04, 2025. Winners are responsible for complying with all Internal Revenue Service rules for reporting and withholding on gambling and lottery winnings.

You do not need to be present to win.

The drawing will be held at the Spring into Service event presented by the Rotary Club of West Chester and the Greater West Chester Rotary Foundation on April 4, 2025. The event will be held at the West Chester Golf & Country Club, 111 West Ashbridge Street, West Chester, PA 19380. Purchasing a Raffle ticket does not grant you admission to the Spring into Service event. Discounted event tickets will be available for Raffle ticket buyers to purchase.

7. Prizes

Grand Prize: \$15,000; Nonprofit Benefactor Grand Prize: \$15,000; Nonprofit Benefactor Consolation Drawing: \$5,000 (non-profit grand prize winner is not eligible); Nonprofit Benefactor Consolation Group (non-drawing winners): \$2,500 each; Grand Prize Winning Ticket Seller Prize \$500; Nonprofit Benefactor Grand Prize Winning Ticket Seller: \$500. Prizes are contingent on all 3000 tickets being sold. In the event that all 3000 ticket are not sold, the prizes will be adjusted in accordance with the percentage of ticket sold.

8. Photographs Video & Media Release

Prize winner(s) agree to grant permission for my name photographs or video clips to be used in publications, advertisements and social media outreach supporting the Rotary Club of West Chester, the Greater West Chester Rotary Foundation its' programs services and/or products. Permission maybe revoked at any time for the above, in writing.

9. General Conditions

In the event that the operation, security, or administration of the Raffle is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to fraud, unauthorized human intervention or other technical problem, or in the event the Raffle is unable to run as planned for any other reason, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, the Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, either (a) suspend the Raffle to address the impairment and then resume the Raffle in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Rules or (b) terminate the Raffle. The Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Raffle or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to damage undermine the legitimate operation of the Raffle may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such an attempt be made, the Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages (including attorney's fees) and any other remedies from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. Failure by the Sponsor to enforce any provision of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

10. Release and Limitations of Liability

By participating in the Raffle, entrants agree to release and hold harmless the Sponsor, and each of their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotion agencies, other companies associated with the Raffle, and each of their respective officers, directors, representatives, and agents (the Released Parties) from and against any claim or cause of action arising out of participation in the Raffle or receipt or use of the prize (including any travel or activity related thereto), including, but not limited to: (a) any technical errors associated with the Raffle; (b) unauthorized human intervention in the Raffle; (c) mechanical, network, electronic, computer, human, printing or typographical errors; (d) any other errors or problems in connection with the Raffle, including, without limitation, errors that may occur in the administration of the Raffle, the announcement of the winner(s), the cancellation or postponement of the event and/or in any Raffle-related materials; or (e) injury, death, losses or damages of any kind, to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from ticket holders participation in the Raffle or acceptance, receipt or misuse of the prize (including any travel or activity related thereto). Ticket holder further agrees that in any cause of action, the Released Parties liability will be limited to the cost of entering and participating in the Raffle, and in no event shall the entrant be entitled to receive attorney's fees. Released Parties are also not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by site users, tampering or by any equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Raffle. Ticket holder waives the right to claim any damages whatsoever, including, but not limited to, punitive, consequential, direct, or indirect damages.

11. Disputes

Except where prohibited, each entrant agrees that any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of, or connected with, the Raffle or any prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate court located in Pennsylvania. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, entrants rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of the Sponsor in connection with the Raffle, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of Pennsylvania, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules, which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than Pennsylvania.
